The UK Government has introduced an eVisa system, as part of the transition to a fully digital border and immigration system.

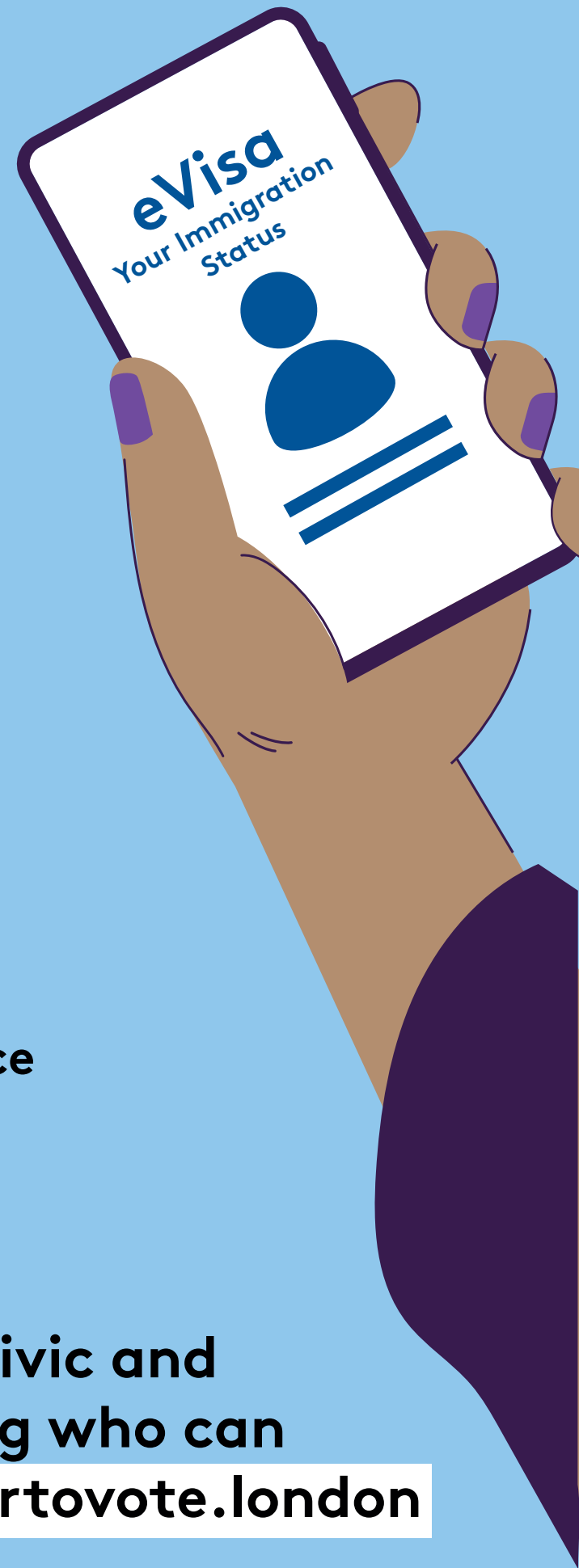
What is an eVisa?

eVisas are a type of biometric immigration document and can be used as an accepted form of photo ID to vote in person, at a polling station.

To use your eVisa as Voter ID, you need to:

Log in to your GOV.UK eVisa account.

Show the eVisa on your mobile phone or device to polling station staff on election day.
